1. Go to [jfks.de](http://jfks.de)
2. Click on **Elementary School**.
3. Click on **The ES Library**.

(For **DIRECTIONS** on reading eBooks on iPads, tablets, iPhones, smart phones, click on **Electronic Resources**.)

4. Click on **Library Catalog** and again on **Online Catalog**.
5. Click on the second tab **Catalog**.
6. Click on the third tab on the left, **Destiny Discover**, to see our eBook titles.

## STUDENT CHECK OUT PROCEDURES

- **Grade 2:** Checkout 2 books for 1 week (no graphic novels).
- **Grades 3-6:** Checkout 5 items (books, audio CDs, magazines, DVDs,\* graphic novels\*) for 2 weeks.



\*Limit 2: Graphic Novels. 1 Eng 1 Ger. 1 DVD only after 4 items are checked out.

Please return your books on time or renew them if they are late!

Students MUST bring the book in to the library to renew it.

## LOST BOOKS & FINES

**LATE BOOKS:** There are no late fines. If a book is over a month late, the book must be paid for in order to continue checking out books from the library. Parents will receive weekly email reminders of overdue books.

**LOST BOOKS:** Please do not replace a lost book. Talk with a librarian to know replacement cost.

## PARENTS' HOUR



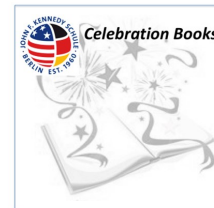
Wednesdays from 13:30 to 15:00.\*
