II. <u>Topics:</u>

- 1. MSA presentation:
 - Time for presentation as a single exam 10-15 min., otherwise 10 min.
 - Students should check topics, spelling, grammar before signing
 - Mentoring teacher should advise them on s-genitive, apostrophe, affect/effect, to what extent, no abbreviations
 - Students have to turn in from sheet till 17th/18th January 2023
 - All forms and information are found at https://jfks.de/students/10th-grade-msa/
 - Teacher should offer a meeting with students, if students haven't made an appointment with them yet
 - If the teachers reach out and students don't respond/Students don't show up with no excuse, teacher should document via email. The offer counts as a meeting. ⇒3 meetings a 40 min. should take place, because students need mentoring; students have responsibility to respond and to take care of the meetings as well
 - The first meeting is about media they use, the outline prospect of the presentation, the started research, discuss protocol what will be graded
 - Students are NOT allowed to send any teacher slides/their presentation, because the teacher could be a member of the judges/commission/ Students aren't allowed to show their presentation before the exam
 - The quantity/quality of the content should be divided fairly between the students of a group
- 2. Double hours in science classes:
 - Teachers exchange the experiences and opinions about advantages and disadvantages of double hours, TS will forward the topic to the admin
 - Advantages: More time for experiments/modeling, more time for pieces which can be learned around a topic (Einstieg, Mittelbau, Ende, repeat 10', summary 10 ', more time for topic/observation/conclusion), great for lab experiences, you get a lot of work done, students are always rushing between classes have time for a real break/eating/drinking: if you put the 5' break between the double hours at the end they'll have a little more time for break, new learning atmosphere
 - Disadvantages: Due to holidays such as Thanksgiving etc. some classes (depending on the day) miss a lot of lessons, learning experience: students have subject then only twice a week and forget a lot/ higher "risk" to forget, on the other hand impact stronger/"felt" better remembrance, room issue: not enough rooms to do labs every week
 - Suggestion of 5-10 min homework after double hours about the main topics of the lesson: what have we done etc.
- 3. Bio gap year in 8th grade an issue with new changes to curriculum for LK Bio/AP Bio
 - Bio-chem contents superficially in 7th grade

- Very likely revisions of 10th grade curricula Bio + Chem (if applicable 9th grade Bio)
