Conditions for participation in the ski trip and general information

- To register, the registration form must be completed clearly and returned to the sports teacher together with the health declaration by December 1, 2024 at the latest. If your child does not take part in the ski trip, a written notification must be sent to the sports teacher. Your child will then be required to attend school for the duration of the class trip!
- The participant must be healthy and physically able to participate in sports such as skiing.
 Please note that your signature also permits the student to participate in activities such as sledding and hiking.
- The participant must bring a valid passport (or other travel document). (Check the expiration date <u>NOW!</u>)
- All participants are obliged to adhere to the agreed program and to the instructions of the guides and the trip leader.
- In the event of gross violation of the instructions of the trip leader or unaccountable behavior, the participating person may be sent home or picked up at the PARENTS' EXPENSE. This decision is at the discretion of the trip leader. The privilege to participate in the trip may also be lost in the run-up to the trip in the event of bad behavior.
- In case of **sickness** the parents will pay all expenses for medical treatment and transportation home (if necessary) if these expenses are not covered by insurance. Any medical expenses incurred by the ski trip leader in Austria must be paid by the parents immediately after returning into the account listed below. Expenses caused by an accident during school related activities will be covered by the school insurance. Reports must be made to school offices especially if symptoms occur after we return from the trip. Please be aware that any further treatment upon our return to Berlin must be coordinated through a "Durchgangsarzt". This is a special licensed orthopedic and surgical doctor.
- If not privately insured, also bring the **insurance card** or the documents from your insurance company. It is also advisable to take out health insurance abroad.
- There is no baggage insurance provided by the school. The students are responsible for their own luggage and ski equipment.
- Canceling a trip can lead to cancellation costs. Cancellation costs may also be incurred if the entire trip is canceled.
- Students may go on excursions and visits in small groups of at least three people without the supervision of a chaperone, but with their explicit permission.
- The ski trip is a school event. All behavioral guidelines applicable at the school also apply to the ski trip. In the run-up to the trip, parents will inform their children about general behavior and, in particular, about the existing Hate Speech Policy and the ban on alcohol, cigarettes, vape pens and the like.
