**Dear students and parents,**

This will be the last information given concerning this year's ski trip.

We would like to remind you once again:

**For the students there is absolutely no smoking or alcohol allowed during the entire ski trip!! Intimacies are not allowed! Use/ Abuse of any kind of drugs during the trip will lead to an exclusion from further participation!**

Due to limited space on the busses, we request that you bring only one suitcase or duffel bag (normal size) and one small handbag (ski boots separate) per person.

We hope that we have done everything to assure a successful trip. Our thanks go to our colleagues for supporting the trip and our appreciation goes to the parents for their willingness to make the financial sacrifice that the price of the trip means for many families.

Now, the success of the whole trip depends a great deal on YOU, the students.

**DEPARTURE:**

Sunday, March 9, 2025 in front of JFK-School **at 8:00 a.m. Meeting time: 7:15 a.m.**

We'll get our first meal in the evening in Bruck. Therefore please, take enough snacks and drinks for the bus ride.

When checking into the bus, all participants will have their temperature taken. If your child shows a temperature of **more than 38°C (100 F)**, we will NOT take your child with us. A later arrival after your child has recovered is of course possible.

**ARRIVAL in Bruck:**

Depending on the weather and road conditions, we will arrive in the late afternoon or evening. The arrival time can be found shortly afterwards on the JFKS website.

**RETURN TRIP:**

The return trip has been planned for Friday, March 21. Departure from Bruck/Zillertal will be at about 8:00 a.m. Since most students have their own cell phone, the easiest way to inform the parents of our exact arrival time in Berlin would be through personal contact with your child. The approximate arrival time at school will also be posted on the JFKS website (2-3 hours prior to our arrival in Berlin).

On non-skiing days, activities such as hiking, soccer, etc. will be carried out in groups under supervision.

**In case of an accident during school related activities, students are insured through the “Unfallkasse Berlin”. Should there be any further medical treatment necessary upon our return to Berlin, this treatment must be coordinated through a so-called “Durchgangsarzt”. These are special licensed orthopedic and surgical doctors. A private travel insurance may be considered.**

**Organizational details for the day of departure and in Austria:**

1. All students please be on the bus ramp at school on 09.03.2025 at 07:15h. Important: Please **NO PARKING** at the school's bus stop. The bus stop and the ramp must be kept free for the buses.
2. Students with **last name A - Ma** please enter the ramp from the **northern** entrance (direction Zehlendorf Mitte). All students with the **last name Mc - Z** please enter the bus ramp from the **southern** entrance (direction Teltow).
3. Please leave your luggage on the side near the school fence.
4. We ask students and parents to help load the buses.
5. Before boarding the bus, an attendance check is carried out and the temperature is measured. Once the bus has been boarded, it can no longer be left. Students who get travel-sick should take a seat at the front of the bus. Otherwise there is no seating arrangement.
6. Please refrain from unnecessary social contact prior to the trip to avoid exposure to illnesses.
7. Please do not forget your vaccination card and hand it in at the bus together with your passport/ID and your health insurance card in an envelope with your name on it.
8. Students may also be sent home for disciplinary reasons at the parents' expense. Normally this is done by train from Jenbach/Inntal to Berlin.
